

EASTWOOD TENNIS COURT

At the present time the residents of Eastwood can enjoy one of America's favorite recreational sports on the tennis court located at the end of Wimbledon Rd. An excellent court has been provided. The tennis court is available to all residents and may be accessed at west gate **using the key** provided by the association only. There are a few rules that govern the court use.

TENNIS COURT RULES

1. The tennis court is provided for the exclusive use of the members of the Eastwood Community Association, their families, and their guests. Guests will be limited to a maximum of three and must be accompanied by a resident of Eastwood.
2. Play is on first come, first play basis. We ask that you consider those waiting. Limit play to one set if someone is waiting for the court. If you are one that would rather not keep score, limit your use of the court to one hour.
3. Parents are asked to cooperate by encouraging their children to play during the day, leaving the court to our working members on weekdays after 5:00 p.m. In order that everyone has the opportunity to play, we specifically ask that those under 16 years of age yield the court to adults after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday, and holidays.
4. The court is for tennis only. Please refrain from bringing skateboards or roller skates for use on the court surface.
5. Use only shoes designated for tennis.
6. Release net tension after play.
7. Lights are provided for evening and night use. They burn 12,000 watts of electricity per hour. There is a timer installed that limits lighting to one hour. The purpose of the timer is to prevent lights from being inadvertently left on all night, as well as being a convenient way of reminding players when their period of play is up. Please turn off the lights when you leave the court for further savings of your dues.

EASTWOOD BASKETBALL COURT RULES

The basketball court is intended for use by residents and guests only. Please use for basketball only, treat court properly, and be considerate of neighbors in close proximity of the court. Any non-resident using this and other facilities while not a guest of an Eastwood resident is per definition a trespasser and can be reported to the police as such.
