

EASTWOOD POOL RULES

Access the pool area with your authorized key issued by the association only. The gate should remain closed at all times (self-locking gate.) No lifeguard will be on duty; use of pool is at own risk.

1. A cleansing shower shall be taken before entering the pool.
2. Bathers who use tanning products are required to shower before each entry into the pool.
3. Persons with open wounds or symptoms of a communicable disease will not get in the pool.
4. Solo swimming is prohibited. No swimming outside of pool hours.
5. Swimming suits shall be maintained in a clean and sanitary manner. Cut-offs should be hemmed.
5. No running or rough play on the deck or about the pool.
6. NO DIVING. Do not stand on the ladder rails for any reason.
7. A responsible adult (over 17 or parent or guardian) must accompany children ages 13 and under.
8. Pollution of water by any substance is forbidden. Noise may be pollution, too. Keep radios, CDs or tape players at a moderate level.
9. Children who are unable or untrained to use the toilet must have on a clean diaper (disposable preferred) before entering the pool. Any waste in the pool will cause closure for at least 24 hours. Please consider the consequence to others.
10. Inflatable pool objects are allowed in the pool dependent on current occupant load.
11. The following are not allowed in the pool area:
 - SMOKING
 - GLASS CONTAINERS
 - ALCOHOL
 - FOOD
 - DOGS, CATS OR OTHER PETS
12. Residents are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests and are requested to ENSURE conformity to all rules by youths. Eastwood Declarations provide for denial of use for rule violations.
13. Pool hours are 10 AM to 9 PM daily, except when cleaning, chemicals or maintenance is required.
14. Pool capacity is 101.
